I'm working on a web-based product that needs some form of video player. I'm fully aware of how hard HTML5 video is, but I have no idea how to make the job done. Can you recommend a solid HTML5 video player which has a user-friendly implementation? Also, any good Flash-based implementation? Ideally, I need an HTTP:// player that will handle all kinds of HTML5/Flash/whatever, so that's not a deal-killer. EDIT: Let me clarify what I need. I need a WYSIWYG HTML5 video player that is fully compatible with Linux/Windows/Mac and other browsers. It must also be able to handle Flash, or even Java SWF's (.jar), and not open a new browser window. It also needs to be easy to integrate, so that non-programmers can just upload the videos. Also, it needs to be customizable and scalable. EDIT2: I just need something which has pretty much all the features of a Flash-based player, but can handle all kinds of formats.
